
BACKGROUND

Currently the implementation of many educational practices are product-oriented to enable learners to acquire certain skills or understand the learning materials. It can be quite reasonable as the output of education is something easily observed and measured. These are reflected in many educational policies, teaching methods as well as evaluations of learning output which are directed to produce output with certain qualifications. Due to this fact, in carrying out their duties teachers are encouraged to produce learners with certain competences as the output.

The learning process at school and in universities finally becomes a static process which impedes the learners' curiosity, self confidence, creativity, and critical thinking. As a result, the educational practices tend to produce individuals who are not sensitive about and unable to respond to the social changes occuring in their own society.
